A Collaborative Space

Our new space will bring together several incredible organizations on one campus—The Arc of Story County, Overflow Thrift Store, The Well, and of course Friendship Ark—creating a powerful community hub where missions align and impact multiplies.

Accessibility for All

Our current building poses challenges for those using wheelchairs. Our new center will be fully accessible, one level, and located directly on a CyRide route—ensuring that every core member, especially those relying on us as their representative payee, can reach us safely and independently.

Nature-Inspired Refuge

The building's design draws inspiration from the natural world, offering a sense of peace to everyone who walks through the doors. We envision a place of restoration, a sanctuary of belonging.

Room to Grow

With expanded space come greater possibilities—more programming, more partnerships, more lives changed.

Celebrate with Us-On Our Donor Wall

In the heart of our new facility, an Ark donor wall will honor the generous individuals and organizations that made this dream possible. Your support fuels every step we take. We cannot do this without you.
